The study discussed the analysis of expressive utterences found in the lyrics of the song "Love You Like a Love Song" by Selena Gomez and became one of the hits in the music world. This song is known not only for its catchy melody and rhythm, but also for its expressive lyrics full of emotional expressions. The purpose of this study is to examine whether there is a match between song lyrics and the expressive expressions conveyed. The research used descriptive qualitative, namely by analyzing the text and contextual approach to understand the meaning of song lyrics and their effect on listeners. The results of the analysis of expressive utterences in the lyrics show their suitability with the theme of the song and the communicative purpose of conveyed true love. Introduction

Utterence contain a person's actions in communicating which are carried out directly or indirectly through words, phrases or other things with the aim of providing information about the occurrence of certain events and can also contain illocutions to influence the interlocutor. Utterence are a branch of pragmatics which is related to language in society. Based on the opinion of Safitri & Mulyani (2021). Utterance that contain illocutionary intent or force and influence the interlocutor or listener and can be in the form of sounds, words, phrases, sentences or utterances that have a specific intent and influence the listener. Utterence are also units of analysis in the study of pragmatics, such as phonemes, morphemes, words, phrases, clauses and sentences in structural linguistics. Apart from that, speech acts are not only carried out in one direction, but there are also responses by the listener. As expressed by Budiman & Sumarlam (2021). Utterence are communication between speakers and speech partners representing various kinds of social activities using language in a discourse. This, of course, does not only stop at one-way communication, but also at two-way communication, there is the original utterance and the following response or response to the utterance.

The expressive speech made by the speaker has the aim of expressing one's own condition regarding the feelings one is experiencing, be it pleasant, anxious or sad feelings that one is experiencing or has experienced. Based on the opinion of Rohmawati & Diding, (2021). Expressive speech can be synthesized into eleven functions, including: apologizing, thanking, congratulating, sympathizing, praising, complaining, sarcasm, criticizing, accusing, blaming, and condolences. Expressing feelings, either directly or indirectly, is a natural action and a natural thing for humans to do. Therefore, as a human being who has the title of being a social creature, it is important to share stories or experiences with each other so that listeners can learn from them in order to become a

better person. There are so many things that the speaker can do to express himself, which can be done directly through communication between two or more people, can be done through written media in the form of a novel or diary, can also be done through song lyrics, or anything else.

Expressive utterences in music and sound arts is a powerful form of communication without used direct words.
