CHAPTER V

CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTIONS

In this chapter, the researcher stated that there are two parts, namely conclusions and suggestions. Part of the conclusion is made based on the research questions that had been formulated, the research focus, and the results of the research. Meanwhile in the suggestion section, the researcher addressed this research to several related parties.

5.1 Conclusion

Based on the data information obtained from the results and discussion, the researcher drawn conclusions. The researcher collected data from the utterance of the antagonist characters contained of the conversation in the Baby's Day Out movie. After analyzing the data, the researcher found that all the antagonist characters had flouted the four types of maxims of the principle cooperation. The four types are maxims of quantity, maxims of quality, maxims of relation, and maxims of manner. The researcher found 15 data on flouting of maxims from the utterances of the antagonist characters in conversation. There were 4 flouted maxim quantity (26,7 %), 2 of flouted maxim quality (13,3 %), 7 of flouted maxim relation (46,7 %), and 2 of flouted the maxim manner (13,3 %).

From the four types of maxims, the maxim of relation is the type of maxim most often flouted by the antagonist characters in the Baby's Day Out movie. Edgar 3 conversation, Victor 3 conversation and Norbert 1 conversation. The second most

is flouting maxim of quantity done by Edgar 2 conversations, Victor 1 conversation, and Norbert 1 conversation. Then flouting maxim of quality was performed by Edgar in 2 conversations, the last was flouting maxim of manner which was performed by Edgar 1 conversation and Victor 1 conversation. Edgar and other figures flouted the maxim of relation by saying or conveying information that is irrelevant to the statement being conveyed, changing the topic of the conversation, and concluding implicit meanings. This is what make them blatantly disobey the principle of cooperation in maxims. The researchers analyzed the data based on the cooperative principle theory put forward by Cutting. In addition, this research is also supported by relevant theories from several experts related to cooperative principles.

5.2 Suggestions

After the researcher drawn the conclusion, then the researcher presented some suggestions as follows:

1. For the readers, the researcher hope that this research can help the readers to become more familiar with the phenomenon of flouting maxims. Studying the flouting of maxims can help the readers understand the meaning in everyday conversation. This research can also broaden their knowledge in linguistics, especially in flouting maxim on pragmatic subjects. On the other hand, the movie used by the researcher in this study can motivate the readers to watched it, because the movie taught us to be

more careful in doing something, especially if it can actually become a trap for us.

- 2. For the English students, the researcher hope that this research can increased English students' interest in pragmatics subjects, especially in flouting maxims, because this happens in everyday conversation which can stimulate students to be able think critically in finding flouting maxims and identify it. It is also what can encourage them to do the same thing.
- 3. For the other researchers, the researcher hope that this study can encourage other researchers to be interested in similar research in the form of flouting maxims. On the other hand, this research can also be developed further by analyzing other aspects such as the strategies used or other problems such as politeness and impoliteness and the function of flouting maxims which are not included in this research.
