

CHAPTER V

CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTIONS

This chapter contains conclusions and suggestions based on data findings and discussions in the previous chapter. Therefore, conclusions and suggestions can be formulated as follows:

5.1 Conclusion

The researcher conclude that analyzed 129 utterances of Ana Santos as the main character in Upgraded Movie, using Joos' (1976) theory only found four types of language styles: formal style, consultative style, casual style, and intimate style. The consultative style was most common with 62 consultative styles used by her co-workers. Factors influencing Ana Santos' language style using Holmes (1992) theory include setting, participant, topic, and function. Participants were the most influential factor, as they can adapt language styles to build compatibility and mutual understanding. The study highlights the importance of understanding the language styles of characters in their everyday lives.

5.2 Suggestions

The researcher hopes that this research can provide useful suggestions and contributions as follow:

5.2.1 For Teachers

It is hoped that this research it becomes a learning resource or reference to be the best alternative way as a guide in teaching,

especially types of language styles. It can be a guide to improving the quality of learning in studying language styles by teachers through movies for those interested in studying types of language styles and use in several different conditions.
